



Stage 2024 • Movers 3 à 6 ans • Let's go to the circus!

Day 1: Meet Connor the clown!

- Learn about Connor's family and his favorite hobbies
- Craft: Make a clown
- Song: Clown Song

Language focus: Presenting yourself, learning about family members and hobbies, expressing like and dislike

For 3-4 years old: I like swimming. For 5-6 years old: My favourite hobby is drawing.

Day 2: Where is Connor the Clown?

- Learning about jobs and prepositions
- Craft: Make an acrobat
- Song: On, In, Under

Language focus: Learning simple prepositions, learning about circus jobs

For 3-4 years old: He is a clown. He's on the box. For 5-6 years old: She is behind the magician.



Day 3: What does Connor look like?

- Describe the performers and learn about the shapes
- Craft: Make Connor's bike
- Song: Circus Shape Song

Language focus: Using adjectives to describe the performers, describing the shapes we can see at the circus using short sentences (I can see + shape)

For 3-4 years old: He is big. I can see a circle. **For 5-6 years old:** She is loud/quiet. I can see an oval.

Day 4: It's time for a snack

- Learn about food we can eat at the circus and asking politely
- Craft: Make a delicious ice cream
- Song: Ice Cream Song

Language focus: foods, There is/There are, I want, I would like

For 3-4 years old: I want popcorn. There is an ice cream. For 5-6 years old: I would like a hot dog please.

There are four hot dogs.

Day 5: It's showtime!

- Express what we can do when we go to the circus using simple verbs
- Consolidation of vocabulary
- Craft: Make a ticket booth
- Song: Circus Song

Language focus: verbs

For 3-4 years old: I watch the show. I buy a ticket. For 5-6 years old: I stand in line.
