

**Summary:** Over the course of the week, the students will travel through a Caribbean villagewhere a crime has taken place. They will discover different cultural aspects of the island while interviewing suspects and revealing evidence. They will enhance their listening, reading, writing and discussion skills before cracking the case.

## Day 1: Discover the Crime Case

- · Introductions and ice-breaker games
- · Explore a Caribbean island and the places in the village
- · Discover the crime case and initial discussions
- Language focus: The imperative

### Day 2: Discovering Caribbean Cuisine

- Learn about traditional Caribbean dishes
- · Examine a fact file of all potential suspects
- Interview with one of the village restaurant's staff
- Language focus: Forming questions and interview structures

### Day 3: Let's go to a Festival

- · Walk through a typical market, interview a vendor
- · Create your own island souvenir using origami
- · Learn about a Caribbean music festival and traditional dances
- Language focus: Simple past vs. past continuous





# Day 4: Scuba Diving

- Read about a current free diving champion
- Decode a message in a bottle
- Create a promotional travel brochure
- Language focus: Modal verbs: can & can't

### Day 5: Crack the Case

Gather evidence and have a group discussion to crack the case
Write and present your police report
Language focus: Consolidation and review

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
